Silent Night – a *very* low budget dark-comedy invasion-thriller about crime, class and Christmas. (Fargo Film Festival 2022, and 5 other festivals)

None of The Above – short film adapted from a play by Tom Crawshaw. Official selection: Leeds International Film Festival (2020), and 12 other festivals. Winner, Best Dark Comedy, Houston Comedy Festival (2020), and 5 other awards.

Jack Rabbit – an absurdist, pulpy spoof-torture flick. Part satire, part love letter. But mostly satire. Written with Tom Crawshaw and Rob Vernon. (10 festival selections and awards)

Alex – A short film about grief and sexuality in Berlin. Winner: Best Film, SWIFF (2016)

Missing Something – 12 x 5' web sitcom. Written with Leila Sykes and Tom Crawshaw. (Guardian Top 5 webseries, 2013)

Fanboy – Yaz directed one-man play about politics and nostalgia, written by Joe Sellman-Leava. Worklight Theatre Company. Vault Festival 2020 and 2023 and a successful run at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival 2022. Soho Theatre in November 2022. Winner: Best Director, Dark Chat Awards 2022

A Midsummer Night's Dream – assistant director on Joe Hill-Gibbons' avant-garde production. Young Vic.

Boris: World King – comedy play written by Tom Crawshaw, directed by Yaz. Mayor of London, Boris Johnson, decides to put on an autobiographical play. When it's sabotaged by an unruly audience, his own buffoonery, and a spiteful god, can his political ambition save the day? Three's Company. Trafalgar Studios and Edinburgh Fringe.

Titus Andronicus: Yaz directed an all-female production - A visual, visceral, brutally farcical fresh take on Shakespeare's bloodiest play, using gallons of red paint. Smooth Faced Gentlemen Theatre Company. Regional Tour and Edinburgh Fringe. Winner: John Beecher Award (2013); Best Production, Buxton Fringe (2013).

Not The Messiah – play written by Tom Crawshaw. A heartbreakingly funny one-man odyssey about Graham Chapman: unwitting champion of gay liberation and the only non-living member of Monty Python. Three's Company. Regional Tour. Edinburgh Fringe.
