SCREENWRITING

SENSATIONS – a drama in which a brother and his younger sister are torn apart by envy, disdain and hedonistic excess whilst trying to make it as artists in the 1990s. Developed on 4Screenwriting.

FOUNDLING – a psychological thriller about a social worker hunting for two missing babies and their mothers. Foundling was successfully entered for 4Screenwriting 2025.

DIRT – a period drama loosely based on the real diaries of scullery maid Hannah Cullwick, who had a lifelong secret BDSM relationship with upper class amateur sociologist, Arthur Munby. Dirt was shortlisted for the 2024 BBC Writers Room Programme and was included in Philip Shelley's Script Library.

HOPE AGAINST HOPE – a comedy ripped from the headlines of Liberty's life.

Liberty is a writer, painter and mother with a background working in mental health service research and community services.

After studying Sociology at Bristol University, Psychoanalytic Theory at UCL, Infant Observation at The Tavistock and Portman, and Psychology at London South Bank University, Liberty began a career in mental health across the NHS and educational institutions, roles included: Nursing Assistant, Outreach Worker, Research Worker and Guest Lecturer.

Liberty has volunteered as an honorary psychotherapist at Parkside Clinic, a refugee support worker in Greece and on a service user advisory panel for ESMI at Kings College London.
